Thank you so much for sending the draft of the CHAPMAN genealogy that you plan to publish in the newsletter. We would be interested in receiving a copy of the completed one. Please let us know when you are ready to publish it and the cost.

You have certainly done a mountain of research on this family. I did not see any glaring or otherwise errors, I think you've done an excellent job. We have not been actively researching for some time....so have nothing to add.

I cannot prove the relationship of the PLUMMERS located in Mason and Fleming county KY. As far as I know there has not been any data surfaced that would "nail down" the parents of these children. Circumstantial evidence would point to that being a fact.

We do plan a research trip in August which might possibly end up in this area of Ohio and KY. If we do find anything I will certainly forward it to you.

Thanks again for remembering us and please let us know about the publishing of the upcoming Chapman genealogy and the cost. Enclosed is a check for \$3.00 to cover your cost of the postage and copies that you sent.

Dear Gil,

I want to send you an update and a correction to the William Chapman and wife Eleanor information. We spent a couple of days in Fleming county KY the first of August and also in Clermont County OH.

I do not believe that James Knox is any relation to the Chapman's at all. It appears from the records that he had a military grant of land in Clermont/Brown County OH and was merely selling land to various persons. The deed that led us to believe that he may have been Eleanor's father was just directing his Executors to conclude any land dealings that he had prior to his death.

In Clermont Co. OH there was an early Chapman family...Edward Chapman who died in 1825 with a will. He was dealing in land about 1801. His children were: John, Nancy Noland, William, Rachel Husong, Elizabeth Dillon, Zachariah, Rebecca, & Robert. He may have been from Berkley Co. VA. Do you think that our William could have been related to him?

After taking a good look at what records are available in Fleming County I am not at all sure that George Plummer is the father of Thomas K. & Jeremiah. The early Plummer's were George, Benjamin, Samuel, James and Isaac. Any one of them except Isaac could have been their father.
