"Dr. Robert Lee Davis, McKinney, Texas, a practicing physician for sixty years, died September 30, 1952 in a McKinney hospital, following a short illness. Dr. Davis was born on November 6, 1865 in Farmersville, Texas to John A. and Sarah (Roland) Davis. He attended Farmersville public schools before enrolling in what was then the Memphis Hospital Medical College, Memphis, Tenn., where he was graduated in 1892 and served his internship. He began his medical practice in the vicinity of Princeton, Texas. In 1917 Dr. Davis moved to McKinney, where he practiced until the time of his death. Dr. Davis was formerly a member for many years of the American Medical Association and the Texas Medical Association through the Collin County Medical Society. He was president of his county medical society in 1948 and served as city and county health officer for several years. Dr. Davis was a member of the Baptist Church."

Obituary from The Daily Courier-Gazette, McKinney, Texas. "Benjamin W. Dugger, who died at 7:00pm Jan. 22, 1932, of a heart attack, after only a few hours illness at his home at Princeton, was buried Sunday afternoon in Pecan Grove cemetery. At the time of his death, he was 63 years and 28 days old. He was born in Collin County, Dec 24, 1868. His parents were Wiley and Rachael Dugger, a Collin County pioneer couple.

He had resided in Collin County all of his life and was a member of the Christian Church. His surviving children are Mrs. Walter Davis of McKinney, and Mrs. D.C. McMurray of Greenville, Texas. His surviving brothers are John T. Dugger, living three or four miles out of McKinney, James L. Dugger of Dallas, Lee Dugger of McKinney, and George Dugger of Alexandria, La. He is also survived by two sisters. He was a brother of the late Mrs. M.W. Younger, mother of Isom Younger of McKinney.

The funeral services were conducted at 2:00pm Sunday, Jan 24, 1932 at the residence in Princeton by Rev. Clifford S. Weaver and Rev. A.H. Snider. His burial followed in Pecan Grove cemetery under the direction of John K. Wilson, Princeton undertaker."

File No. 14173 J.N. Chapman, Farmersville, Collin Co., Texas; Date of application: 15 September 1908. Age 64 years. Has resided in Collin County 52 years. Laborer. Weak, has rheumatism, bronchitis, heart and kidney trouble. Served Co. F (Bumpass's Co.) 5th Texas Cavalry (Martin's), from August 1862 until discharged May 1865. Property: pony and buggy worth not exceeding \$400. No wife. (Note: J.N. Chapman was married twice; both his wives were deceased by this time. Indigent except for outside help. Witnesses: R. Van Brown, S. M. Harris.

Letter from War Department, Washington, D. C., states that J.N. Chapman, private, Co. F, 5th Partisan Rangers, Texas Cavalry, enlisted 30 July 1862 and was reported present 15 February 1863. W.P. Bumpass, age 75 years, of Farmersville, Collin Co., Texas, states that he has known applicant since 1857 and they served in same company.

B.A. Redwine, age not given, states that his father, Joseph Redwine, was 1st Lieutenant of Co. F., 5th Texas Cavalry. He heard his father say that when Capt. Bumpass was absent, applicant asked to leave to go home to see his family and Redwine gave him a furlough. Correspondence between O.H. Rodes, County Judge of Rains County, Texas and State Comptroller concerning death of applicant.

Application for Mortuary Warrant: Filed by J.L. Russell, son-in-law. J.N. Chapman died 10 November 1917 at home of J.L. Russell, 6 miles southwest of Emory, Rains County, Texas. Buried Huson Cemetery, Collin County, Texas. Undertaker: J.A. Ames. Cause of death given by Dr. P.W. Pearson: chronic rheumatism.

John Newton Chapman is buried in the South Huson Cemetery in Farmersville, Collin County, Texas.

He married Mary Polly Higdon on Apr 13, 1809 in Barren, Kentucky, USA. Arthur L. Davis was shown as a bondsman on the marriage bond for his sister Nancy Davis and James D. Walker. Arthur bought and sold some land ca 1835 in Tennessee probably just before leaving for Texas. A lawsuit brought by his brother in law Gabriel Higdon (brother of Arthur's wife, Mary Polly Higdon) against his brother Henry Davis in 1839 states that Arthur was "supposed to be a citizen of the State of Texas". Gabriel Higdon is also shown as the surety for Arthur L. Davis and Polly Higdon.

1850 Census for Fannin County, Texas shows A. L. Davis, age 76 (error), born in North Carolina (error), living with his sons John M. Davis (age 30), and Elijah Davis (age 28), and unmarried daughter, N. E. Davis (age 16). Also listed are James C. Keltner (age 19) future husband of Nancy Elizabeth Davis. There are also some Wells family members.

1860 Census for Denton County, Texas shows Arthur L. Davis, age 77, born in Virginia, living with his daughter, Susan Davis Wells, wife of James Wells. Elijah Davis, a son of Arthur L. Davis (listed as idiot in 1850 census) is also living with his father and sister.

William was a member of Ancient Free & Accepted Masons, Lodge No. 214, Farmersville, Collin County, Texas according to the proceedings of the M.W. Grand Lodge of Texas and the minutes of the 25th annual meeting held 10 Jun 1861 showing both W.P. Chapman and D.D. Graham as being Master Masons. Also the minutes of the 30th meeting held 11 Jun 1866 showing D.D. Graham as the W.M. of the lodge and W.P. Chapman as treasurer with W.D. Chapman, son of W.P. Chapman, as J.D.. Reference: Library of the Masonic Temple in Fort Worth, Texas.

Page 222..."John Yeary was born in Virginia in 1796. In 1830, when a captain in the United States Army in Tennessee he was ordered to take charge of the cutting and baling of hay in Arkansas for use in army posts throughout the southwest. His family accompanied him to this new post. In 1839 he resigned his commission in the army and settled on North Sulphur River near present Honey Grove. In March, 1841, while he and his small son and a Negro slave, Anderson, were working in the field, a party of fifteen Indians approached his cabin. His daughter saw them in time to close and bolt all doors. Hearing the commotion, the three hurried to the scene. The savages met them at the yard fence and here a fierce conflict ensued, the Indians firing arrows and snapping two guns at the defenders while Yeary was using a large eye hoe with telling effect, thus preventing the Indians from taking good aim with their arrows. The redskins then changed their tactics, attacking with unstrung bows and striking Yeary over the head and shoulders. Mrs. Yeary and the daughter then suddenly opened the door and delivered two loaded guns to Yeary and his son, but not before Mrs. Yeary was wounded with two arrows. Upon seeing the guns, the Indians fled. Yeary sent Anderson to Albert Early's place, five miles eastward, for assistance. William H. Bourland, who later wrote an account of the incident, was visiting Early when Anderson arrived. Early and Bourland hurried to Yeary's rescue but upon arrival found everything under control except Mrs. Yeary's wounds and Yeary's lacerated head and face. When this attack occurred Walter Yeary, then twenty-two years of age, was in Shreveport purchasing supplies.

In 1842 John Yeary accompanied E.H. Tarrant on an expedition against the Indians and was on a scouting party with John B. Denton when the latter was killed. In 1844 Yeary was one of five men empowered to select a right-of-way, have it cleared, and bridges built for the Central National Road of Texas. These five men and others who helped build the road were to be paid in land. Twelve of them selected tracts near the present town of Floyd, in west Hunt County, but most of them except Yeary, later abandoned their claims. Yeary received 640 acres, located two or three miles northwest of Floyd. In 1845 the Yeary family moved to a place two miles northeast of present Farmersville. This community was at first called "Yeary's Place" but was later named "Sugar Hill."

Captain Yeary was killed while trying to act as a peacemaker during an affray in his store at Sugar Hill on December 24, 1854. He was buried beside his first wife in the Jones-Yeary cemetery a mile and a half northeast of Farmersville.

Page 379...In 1818 in Maury County, Tennessee, he married Polly Shinnault (Mary Elizabeth Chinault), daughter of Isaac and Margaret Shinnault. The Yearys left Maury County when Polly developed typhoid fever. Captain Yeary took a contract to furnish hay for the fort's livestock. During his military career he was with Andrew Jackson when he led a company against the Creek Indians in Pensacola, Florida. It is possible he fought with Jackson in the Battle of New Orleans as family tradition says each year he celebrated a Victory dinner in which all the slaves participated on the anniversary of the battle. His military records show he helped move the Cherokee Indians from Mississippi. Captain John said "he was never a citizen of Arkansas, he was only water-bound in Arkansas for ten years."

The Yeary's joined a group for Texas which crossed Red River at Warren's Bend, north of Honey Grove, on January 2, 1839 and settled on the south bank of the Sulphur River on a land grant given by the Republic of Texas....Captain John, a six foot, 200 lb., red headed Irishman...

From there, he emigrated to Virginia where he patented 400 acres on 18 Apr 1670, in the Parish of Stratton Major, then in New Kent Co. "on the road Piscataway", Virginia. He returned to England, married Rachel Eastham in 1672 and returned to Virginia in 1680 aboard his own ship. Giles Sr. and Rachel had six children - three born in England, one born on-board ship, and two born in America.

According to "John Rogers, Revolutionary War Soldier, and His Relics in Kentucky", a Giles Rogers of Worcestershire, England set sail in 1680 for Virginia. His wife and three children accompanied him on the journey. Just before landing, another son, John Rogers, was born. Thomas Warren's second wife, Elizabeth (Spencer) Shepard died before 1659 as Thomas Warren, Jr., eldest son of third wife, was born in that year. His third wife was Jane, widow of John King, who married thirdly, Samuel Plaw. Thomas Warren made his will March 16, 1669 and same was probated April 21, 1670, by his son William. If the will was recorded in Surry the recording has been lost.

It was Thomas Warren who built the famous brick house in Surry, now called the "Warren House", owned and operated under the auspices of the Association for the Preservation of Virginia Antiquities. Smith's Fort Plantation

occupied a site on the south side of the James River, in what is now Surry County, near Gray's Creek. There, Smith and a party of settlers had built a fort as a refuge should Jamestown be attacked by Indians or Spanish forces, the two great concerns of his day. Later, the land itself was given by Chief Powhatan to John Rolfe upon Rolfe's marriage to his daughter Pocahontas.

The couple's son, Thomas Rolfe, inherited the land, and sometime later in the seventeenth century, another owner, Thomas Warren built a house on the property. The house that now occupies the site, first called the John Rolfe House but now known as the Rolfe-Warren House, probably dates to the mid-eighteenth century, when it served as the home of the Jacob Faulcon family.

The date and location of the birth of Estienne Cheneau have not been positively determined, but some assumptions can be made from information that is known about him. He is listed on the manifest of the Nassau, which landed in Yorktown, Virginia, on 5 Mar 1700/1701. The entry is in French and is shown as Estienne Cheneau et sa femme, inferring the immigrant arrived with his wife, but without children. It has generally been assumed by most

researchers that they were probably married not long before departing for the New World. This assumption has led to the probability that Estienne was born no later than about 1680, thus being about 20-21 years old when he arrived in America. But, he could possibly have been born as early as 1665-1670 if he was about 50 years old at the time of his death, which was the average life expectancy in the time he lived.

As to the location of his birth, it was likely not in France as previously assumed, although his parents descended from French Huguenots. Earlier research proposed that he was born and raised in the Province Languedoc, a few miles west of Marseille. The small city of Nimes, with Avignon nearby, and the mouth of the Rhone, were thought to have been his habitat. However, this does not seem to be plausible. Aboard the Nassau, which was the fourth ship funded by the Protestant Relief Fund in England to relocate Huguenots to America, were 191 Huguenot passengers from the continent. The origin of the passengers aboard each of the four vessels that were part of the effort, however, differed. Thus, most researchers agree that Estienne's being in the fourth group indicates that he was most likely born in the Netherlands to parents descended from French Huguenots, who probably had fled the persecutions in France by possibly as much as a century before his death. And, because they fled to the Netherlands, they likely were from the northern regions of France rather than the Province Languedoc.

A petition dated 19 Apr 1707 and written in French and submitted to Colonel Edmund Jennings, Chairman of the Executive Council in Virginia on behalf of resident of Manakin, Virginia, by C. Philippe de Richebourg, Minister of the Huguenots in Manakin, confirms that Estienne went to Manakin after debarking the Nassau and resided there for at least six years as his is one of five signatures that appear on the petition besides that of Richebourg. Prior to the discovery of the petition several months ago, researchers did not believe that Estienne went to Manakin, but proceeded to Essex County and settled there. Evidently, this was incorrect.

This discovery reveals several other things about Estienne. He was able to sign his name on the petition, so now it is a mystery as to why he could manage only an "X" on the earliest documents in Essex County in 1714. Also, it appears to give merit to the belief of current researchers that his marriage to a Miss Howlett would have been his second marriage, which occurred more than six years after landing in America, since only Huguenots were in Manakin, and Miss Howlett was from an English family long in America. William Howlett was a neighbor to the Chenaults in Essex County. Thus, Estienne's son, Howlett, thought to be named for his mother's maiden name, would not have been born before about 1708 and more likely a couple of years or so later.

Estienne shows up in public records for the first time as Stephen Chenault, the Anglicized version of his name, in Essex County, Virginia in 1714. It is presumed that like most of the traditional Huguenots, he departed Manakin shortly after the 1707 petition, which was rejected by the Council. His whereabouts until he is found in 1714 are unknown. While he could have moved on to Essex County at that time, there is no record of him there. He may have moved to North or South Carolina for a while as did some of the Huguenots, but again nothing substantiates this. Judging by the assumed date of birth of Howlett being about 1712, Estienne, now using the Anglicized Stephen Chenault, must have been in Essex County and married to Howlett's mother by about 1711.

Early researchers of the family have disagreed about the number of children fathered by Estienne. Current opinion is that only three are confirmed in public records. He had one son, Stephen, his first-born, by his first wife who arrived with him in America. This son was born shortly after their arrival at Manakin. It is not known what became of his first wife or if there were other children born to them. It is believed that Estienne, then known as Stephen, married a second time to Miss Howlett about 1711. They had two sons, Howlett and John. Both Howlett and John died as young adults. Both were married and had small children when they died. Howlett's widow, Mary, remarried to William Ballard, which qualified the two of them to serve as co-executors of Howlett's estate.

Estienne is believed to have died within 2-3 years after 1715, when his witnessing of the will, above, demonstrates he was then still living. From 1720 forward, the references to Stephen Chenault in public records in the area are believed to refer to the son of the immigrant, who bore the same name.
